Initiation (new start) criteria, criteria for current Kaiser Permanente members already taking the medication who have not been reviewed previously, and criteria for new members entering Kaiser Permanente already taking the medication who have not been reviewed previously: Non-formulary brivaracetam (Briviact) will be covered on the prescription drug benefit when the following criteria are met:

- Prescribed by a neurologist
- Diagnosis of partial-onset seizures
- Patient has failed an adequate trial[^] of, or patient has an allergy or intolerance^{*} to levetiracetam, and at least 4 other antiepileptic medications

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
