Criteria-Based Consultation Prescribing Program CRITERIA FOR DRUG COVERAGE

Stiripentol (Diacomit)

Initiation (new start) criteria, criteria for current Kaiser Permanente members already taking the medication who have not been reviewed previously, and criteria for new members entering Kaiser Permanente already taking the medication who have not been reviewed previously: Non-formulary stiripentol (Diacomit) will be covered on the prescription drug benefit for 12 months when the following criteria are met:

- Prescribed by a neurologist
- Patient is 6 months old or older and weighs 7 kg or more
- Prescribed for seizures associated with Dravet Syndrome
- Patient is currently treated with clobazam
- Patient has failed an adequate trial of, or patient has an allergy or intolerance to:
 - o Cannabidiol AND
 - At least 2 other antiseizure medications

<u>Continued use criteria for patients previously approved per the above criteria who are currently stable on the medication</u>: Non-formulary stiripentol (Diacomit) will continue to be covered on the prescription drug benefit for <u>12 months</u> when the following criteria are met:

- Prescribed by a neurologist
- Patient has experienced sustained improvement in seizure control (frequency and/or severity) since starting medication as assessed and documented by neurologist

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
