CRITERIA FOR DRUG COVERAGE

Cenegermin-bkbj (Oxervate)

Notes:

- Quantity Limits: Yes
- ^ Adequate trial is defined as 3 months treatment duration with worsening symptoms
- * Intolerance excludes adverse drug reactions that are expected, mild in nature, resolve with continued treatment, and do not require medication discontinuation

Initiation (new start) criteria: Non-formulary **cenegermin-bkbj (Oxervate)** will be covered on the prescription drug benefit for 2 months when the following criteria are met:

- Patient has a diagnosis of moderate-to-severe neurotrophic keratitis (NK)
- Patient has failed an adequate documented trial[^] of OTC preservative free tears, Vital Tears, and lubricant ointments or patient has an allergy or intolerance* to OTC tears and lubricant ointments

Criteria for new members entering Kaiser Permanente already taking the medication who have not been reviewed previously: Non-formulary **cenegermin-bkbj (Oxervate)** will be covered on the prescription drug benefit for a total of 2 months when the following criteria are met:

- Patient has a diagnosis of moderate-to-severe neurotrophic keratitis (NK)
- Patient has failed an adequate documented trial[^] of OTC preservative free tears and lubricant ointments or patient has an allergy or intolerance* to OTC tears and lubricant ointments
