

# Criteria-Based Consultation Prescribing Program

## CRITERIA FOR DRUG COVERAGE

### OxyCODONE ER (OxyContin)

**Notes:**

- ^ Adequate trial is defined as a minimum of 2-week treatment duration with titration as needed.
- \* Intolerance excludes adverse drug reactions that are expected, mild in nature, resolve with continued treatment and do not require med discontinuation.

**Initiation (new start) criteria and criteria for new members entering Kaiser Permanente already taking the medication who have not been reviewed previously:**

Non-formulary **oxyCODONE ER tablet (OxyContin)** will be covered on the prescription drug benefit when the following criteria are met:

- Patient has failed an adequate trial<sup>^</sup> of or has an allergy or intolerance\* or contraindication to oxyCODONE immediate-release, morphine immediate-release, HYDROcodone/acetaminophen , HYDROmorphine immediate-release, morphine sustained-release and fentaNYL transdermal  
-OR-
- Prescriber is a Hospice/Palliative Care clinician  
-OR-
- Patient has active cancer-related pain
