## Criteria Based Consultation Prescribing Program CRITERIA FOR DRUG COVERAGE amphetamine salt combo (Mydayis<sup>®</sup>)

Non-formulary **amphetamine salt combo (Mydayis**<sup>®</sup>) will be covered on the prescription drug benefit when the following criteria are met:

• Diagnosis of ADHD or ADD -AND-

## 1) For patients 13 to 20 years of age:

• Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 days) of amphetamine salt combo XR (Adderall XR), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.

-AND-

• Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 days) of dextroamphetamine ER (Dexedrine Spansule), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.

-AND-

Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 days) of lisdexamfetamine (Vyvanse), unless allergy to an inactive ingredient.

-OR-

• Patient is already stable on the drug.

## 2) For patients 21 years of age or older:

• Prior adequate trial\*\* of amphetamine salt combo XR (Adderall XR), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.

-AND-

• Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 day) of dextroamphetamine ER (Dexedrine Spansule), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.

-AND-

• Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 day) of lisdexamfetamine (Vyvanse), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.

\*\* Adequate trial of a short acting agent is further defined as wearing off that is not resolved by increasing the dose, AND adding a short-acting agent OR increasing frequency to twice daily OR clinically significant side effects related to the dosage form that cannot be resolved by adjusting the dose or timing.
