Criteria-Based Consultation Prescribing Program CRITERIA FOR DRUG COVERAGE

OxyMORphone Immediate release (Opana)

Notes:

- * Adequate trial for treatment failure is defined as a minimum of 2-4 weeks of initial therapy plus at least 1 dose increase (at a 2-4 week interval) without improvement.
- ^ Intolerance excludes adverse drug reactions that are expected, mild in nature, resolve with continued treatment and do not require med discontinuation.

Initiation (new start) criteria: Non-formulary OxyMORphone Immediate release

(Opana) will be covered on the prescription drug benefit when the following criteria are met:

- Documented treatment failure after an adequate trial* of immediate-release formulations of oxyCODONE, morphine, HYDROcodone, and HYDROmorphone -OR-
- Allergy, intolerance[^], or contraindication to oxyCODONE, morphine, HYDROcodone, and HYDROmorphone

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
