| What is the overall deductible? | \$5,500 Individual / \$11,000 Family | Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan , each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible . |
| Are there services covered before you meet your deductible? | Yes. Preventive care and services indicated in chart starting on page 2. | This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost sharing and before you meet your deductible . | Are there other deductibles for specific services? | No. | You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services. |
| What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan? | \$9,000 Individual / \$18,000 Family | The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan , they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met. |
| What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit? | Premiums , health care this plan doesn't cover, and services indicated in chart starting on page 2. | Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit . |
| Will you pay less if you use a network provider? | Yes. See www.kp.org or call 1-888-865-5813 (TTY: 711) for a list of network providers . | This plan uses a provider network . You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network . You will pay the most if you use an out-of-network provider , and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your plan pays (balance billing). Be aware, your network provider might use an out-of-network provider for some services (such as lab work). Check with your provider before you get services. |
