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Important Announcement: Recall of Lamotrigine 100 mg Tablets by Taro Pharmaceuticals

Dear Kaiser Permanente Member,

You may be affected by a recent recall of Lamotrigine 100 mg Tablets manufactured by Taro Pharmaceuticals.

If you are no longer taking this medication or no longer have a supply of this medication, please ignore this letter. If you have a supply of this medication, here is what you need to know about this recall.

Why is Taro Pharmaceuticals recalling this medication?

- Taro Pharmaceuticals announced the recall because one lot (batch) of this medication was contaminated with a small amount of another medication.
- Taro Pharmaceuticals issued the recall to assure the health and safety of people who take this medication.

What should I do with my medication?

- Do not stop taking your medication, this is not an emergency.
- Please bring your medication with this letter to the pharmacy that fills your prescriptions at your earliest convenience.
- The pharmacy will exchange your medication with medication that is not affected by this recall at no charge.
