Cardiology

- CommonSpirit St. Anthony Hospital treats heart attacks 15 minutes faster than the national average.
- Its rapid heart attack response times are some of the quickest interventions (opening a blocked artery) in the nation.
- The hospital is one of the few in Colorado to offer Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO) therapy to patients needing critical respiratory and cardiac support.

Emergency & Trauma Care

- As a Level 1 Trauma Center, CommonSpirit St. Anthony Hospital provides the highest level of care for critically injured patients.
- The hospital is home to T10, a specialized trauma operating room reserved for patients with life-threatening injuries requiring immediate intervention. T10 patients do not go through the emergency room; they are treated within seconds of arriving at the hospital.
