Pocket Talker Set

Amplifies sound to help with hearing. If you have an implant or hearing aid, use with neck loop telecoil coupler.



6X Magnifier

Magnifies documents 6X for easier reading



White Board

Use to draw or write out what you want to say



Boogie Board

Use to draw or write out what you want to say

Communication Board



Point to images to help you communicate



Talking Clock

Announces time. Available in English, Spanish, and as keychains.

Captioned Telephone



Displays words from a phone call as text on a screen

Telephone Sound Amplifier



Amplifies sound to help with hearing. Compatible with neck loops, headsets, T-coils.
