

How to Donate

If your unused medication is on the [Donatable Drug List](#) and is in a sealed, unopened package with more than 6 months before expiration, it may be donated!

Includes:

- Blister pack tablets/capsules
- Syringes in tamper-evident packaging
- Full bottles with manufacture's seal intact
- Refrigerated medications

How do I donate?

- It's easy! All you need to do is bring your prescription to any [KP Pharmacy location](#)
- When you arrive at the pharmacy, let them know that you are “donating to the Drug Donation Program.” They may think you are trying to “dispose” of an expired prescription which is not the case
- A pharmacist will inspect the donation and ask you to sign a [State of Washington Form](#) stating you have not tampered with the medication and that you have stored it appropriately.
- Once you've signed, you're good to go!
